Weekly Programs

Starting January 2019, our school fees, per term, are as follows:

Dropping off and Picking up Children

Parents are encouraged to drop their children in school not later than 07:20 hours. Children brought to school after 08:00hrs will be sent back home. Similarly, picking up children one hour or more late will attract a K50 charge for any hour late and a further K50 for a subsequent hour late. Kindly note that picking up of children should only be done by the same person known by the school, if any parent decides to send a different person to pick up the child, the person should be introduced to us in advance otherwise the school will not release the child to that new person.

Our school buses

Please report any bad driving and unwanted behavior. Children using the bus must observe the rules of the bus, e.g. no eating or drinking in the bus, no standing, no sticking out heads or limbs from the window, etc. Please note that the bus fares have been revised and all concerned parents must note this and collect the new fare chart from the school.

Personal belongings

To ensure that children do not lose their personal belongings, parents are urged to ensure that each child's belongings are clearly labeled with their names. Labels or names should never be written in front or at the back or on the side but can neatly be written inside the School uniforms, jerseys, PE attire and headsocks as they are not part of school uniform but merely meant to identify the owners of those garments.

Homework Policy

Class teachers have been asked to issue homework on a daily basis to the children. Parents need to check books of their children and sign to ensure that this is the case.

A homework makes a triangle learning, which includes a child who is a Centre, a teacher and a parent. Hence parents must make sure the children do their homework effectively.

School Canteen

Meals are served for learners who sign up to eat from the School Canteen. Charges are as follows:
